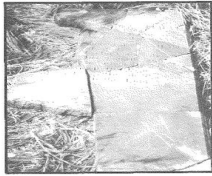


Articles Of Faith And Practice With The Church Covenant: Approved By The Danville Association And Ad

Through his leadership the church (called New Providence) at Hopkinsville was organized June 6, 1818. Will Tandy served as minister at the New Providence Church for almost three years and his economic independence caused him to refuse any monetary contribution from the church.

After a lengthy illness which left his voice severely impaired, Elder Tandy died at his home October 12, 1838. He passed away just as the first caravans of Cherokee Indians were moving through Christian County in sight of his home along their famous "Trail of Tears." He is buried in a field south of and in front of his old home.

Will and Elizabeth Tandy were the grandparents of William T. Tandy, President of First City Bank and Trust Company, 1911 - 1937 and a life long member of First Baptist Church, and the great grandparents of William L. Tandy, Houston, Texas banker and local library benefactor.



William Christian Warfield
Nov. 8, 1823 - Feb. 10, 1827

Elder William C. Warfield, the third minister, was born at Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, in 1796, a son of Dr. Walter Warfield, a Major in the Continental Line in the Revolutionary War, and his wife Sarah Winston Christian. His maternal grandfather was Col. William Christian, the man for whom Christian County was named in 1796.

He entered Transylvania University where he remained for six years, graduating in law. Soon after leaving the university, he stabbed a young man

named Bradford, in the theater at Lexington. Believing the wound to be fatal, young Warfield fled by horseback riding all night and the next day until he reached Bardstown. Here he read law in the office of Judge John Rowan, the builder of Federal Hill, now known as "My Old Kentucky Home." Warfield remained there until he learned that Bradford had recovered.

In 1817, Jeremiah Vardeman visited Bardstown and the young lawyer was converted and united with the Baptist Church. He laid aside his law books and applied himself to the study of the Bible. Returning to Lexington, Warfield was instructed by Dr. James Fishback, who owned an extensive theological library. He was licensed to preach and was ordained into the ministry.

Warfield entered the Princeton Theological Seminary, in New Jersey, where he spent two years. Upon his return to Lexington the young minister moved to Todd County where he married Racheal P. Edwards, February 13, 1822. She was born in Maryland on November 6, 1800, and died in Christian County, on October 7, 1828. They had two children: Matilda and William E. He married Joyce Duguid, in Todd County, April 5, 1831, and they had one daughter, Sarah.

On January 11, 1823, Elder Warfield was received by letter from N. E. Horn church, Scott county, into membership at New Providence church. He was ordained on July 12, and became pastor in November of that year. During his ministry here the church participated in the formation of Bethel Baptist Association and it remained a part of this group until the Christian County Baptist Association was formed in 1923.

In 1825 Warfield became a member of Mt. Zion church near his home, in southwest Todd County. He preached at Salem church in Christian County from 1831 to 1835.

During the course of a meeting he was conducting at Bethel Baptist Church, William C. Warfield died at the home of William Tandy, on November 3, 1835. The Salem and New Providence churches placed a stone crypt over his grave in the Duguid - Mimms graveyard. It is located on the Maurice Chester farm in Todd County, .9 of a mile from Trenton on Highway 104 South.

Mrs. John C. Clardy, a member at Salem Baptist Church spoke of him "as one of the ablest champions of Baptist faith and doctrine, firm in his devotion to his cause; preaching from house to house, or under the trees, and making converts to religion by his untiring labor."
